

## **Notable Projects**

### Churchgate Lions Bhojanshala & Dormitory at Sant Gadge Maharaj Ashramshala, Varvandi, Ahmednagar (MH) and Toy & Books Library Khambhat (Gujarat)

Sant Gadge Maharaj Ashramshala is a charitable school recognised by the government. It provides education and boarding for over 250 students in the district of Ahmednagar. Our club has helped them build a multi-purpose hall for activites, dining and studying. We have built an accomodation block and a toilet block as well.

The toy library was built in Shree Madhavlal Shah High School in Khambhat. Educational and story books, games, toys, sport equipment and stationary items were donated to build a permanent library room.











## **Notable Projects**

## **Rural Welfare: Maharashtra and Gujarat**

The club has been involved in various rural projects of different scale. Initially started off in the sectors of women empowerment and environment through menstrual awareness, distribution of ration and essential items and tree plantation. We have grown to envision and implement projects related to sanitation, waste management and rainwater harvesting through community participation.











# **Notable Projects Vision**



The club does extensive work every year for projects related to vision: eye testing, care and operative procedures. The charitable trust founded and run by the club has various eye camps organised as well as reduced cost checkups.

In association with Sri Ram Van Kutir, Barabanki (UP), a free mega general surgery camp is organized & surgeries such as Hernia, Hydrocele, Uterus (Hysterectomy), Cataract etc. are conducted successfully since the last 20 years. Many patients have benefitted from the same.







## **Notable Projects**

#### Hunger

Various projects related to hunger are a prominent part of the club. We provide lunch at Sant Gadge Maharaj Dharamshala, Dadar and at Shiv Kalyan Kendra, Sion regularly. The club is a part of the mega project 'Paheli Roti Dayitva Ki' in providing a significant number of rotis everyday. Several initiatives of feeding rural children on special occasions have been undertaken.









## **Prospective Projects**

#### 10 Bathroom & Toilet for Girl students, Varvandi

Sant Gadge Maharaj Ashramshala is a charitable school recognised by the government. It provides free education to the students of the neighbouring villages in the district of Ahmednagar. We have been working with the organisation for the past several years and helping them build for the growing needs of their students. Education is of upmost importance for the upliftment of all communities.

Power cuts and improper access to electricity is a common problem in rural India. The school wishes to build a library block powered by renewable solar energy which the students can use to read and study even at night. The library will house books and access to digital reading. Establishing a library cum study room will help the children read and prepare for examinations at night as well. Project budget approx. Rs. 8 Lakhs.





#### Check Dam Project, Palghar region, Maharashtra

Water, even though an abundant resource, is scarce in many places. By certain processes, we may be able to increase the access to water. The region of Palghar and areas around are a tribal belt with limited availability to good drinking water as they solely rely on ground water.

A check dam is a small dam built across a stream to lower the speed of flowing water. Through this intervention, we can collect water as well as increase the seepage of water into the ground. This stored groundwater can then be used in the following months.

After discussions with experts and villagers, a spot has been identified for the project beneficial for the villages of Chalani, Dahanu Taluka, Dist - Thane. The Project Cost is Rs. 14 lakhs. The expected water storage is 8 to 10 TCM. (1 TCM is 10 Litres).

Lions Club of Churchgate in Twinning with Lions Club of Millennials completed this project.

# **Upgradation of X-Ray Imaging Machine for Om Shanti Churchgate Lions JDF Mumbai Medical Centre**

The charitable medical centre is a permanent project jointly run by our club and JDF Mumbai. It is located in Lalbaug, Mumbai and serves large volumes of people on a regular basis. The centre is in need of upgrading the X-Ray imagie processing to a fully digital recording. This will allow the machine to send images directly to the computer and make the process of sharing and printing easier. The suggested Fujifilm FDR SE Lite series model is budgeted at Rs 14 lakhs.


